

## The Mental Welfare Commission for Scotland - Open Data Plan May - 2017

**Explanatory Notes**;

Level 1: data available on the Web (whatever format) under an open license

Level 2: available as structured data (e.g., Excel instead of image scan of a table)

Level 3: available in a non-proprietary open format (e.g., CSV as well as Excel)

Level 4: use URIs to denote things, so that people can point at your data

Level 5: link your data to other data to provide context

**Short Term:** The datasets we published at the moment are all at level 1 which means that our data is updated regularly and is available on our website, but it is not easy to use and combine with other data. (Level 1)

**Medium Term:** We plan to review our monitoring statistics and our PRSA statement with a view to making some but not all of the tables we publish within the PDF documents available in Excel and/or CSV format. (Level 2 or 3)

**Long Term:** We aspire to reviewing progress and upgrading our level where intelligence would suggest that there is a perceived or observed need to do so and where our available resources allow for the necessary preparation work. (Level 4)
