Question 4: Do you have any comments on the revised process as set out above?

There needs to be a differentiation between expected and unexpected deaths. For example, within Forensic mental health services such as the State Hospital, we would usually have at least one expected death due to a diagnosed physical illness such as cancer each year. Whilst it is appropriate that all deaths of people under detention are subject to scrutiny this needs to proportionate. We also need to ensure that the humane practice of giving an individual some choice in their place to live over the last period of their life remains and is not inadvertently thwarted by concerns regarding investigations.

Question 4b: How could such difficulties be addressed?

We would suggest that MWC develops a process to manage expected deaths that did not require a formal investigation but did have a routine required evidence set. If on review, MWC considered that a formal investigation by the local service was required, this should be requested. It should be possible to notify MWC in advance regarding any individual likely to come into this category.
